

HOW TO TAKE A TEMPLATE OF THE HORSE'S BACK - THE TRICK WITH THE WIRE

1. Bend a piece of wire (approx. 45 cm or 18 inch long) or a flexible curve across the horse's back as described in the sketch. Mould the wire/flexible curve to the shape of the horse's body. The first point of measurement is 2 fingers behind the scapula.
2. Lay the tracings on this paper and draw the inside with a pencil.

The black lines on this pattern serve as an example only and not as an indication of your specific measurement.

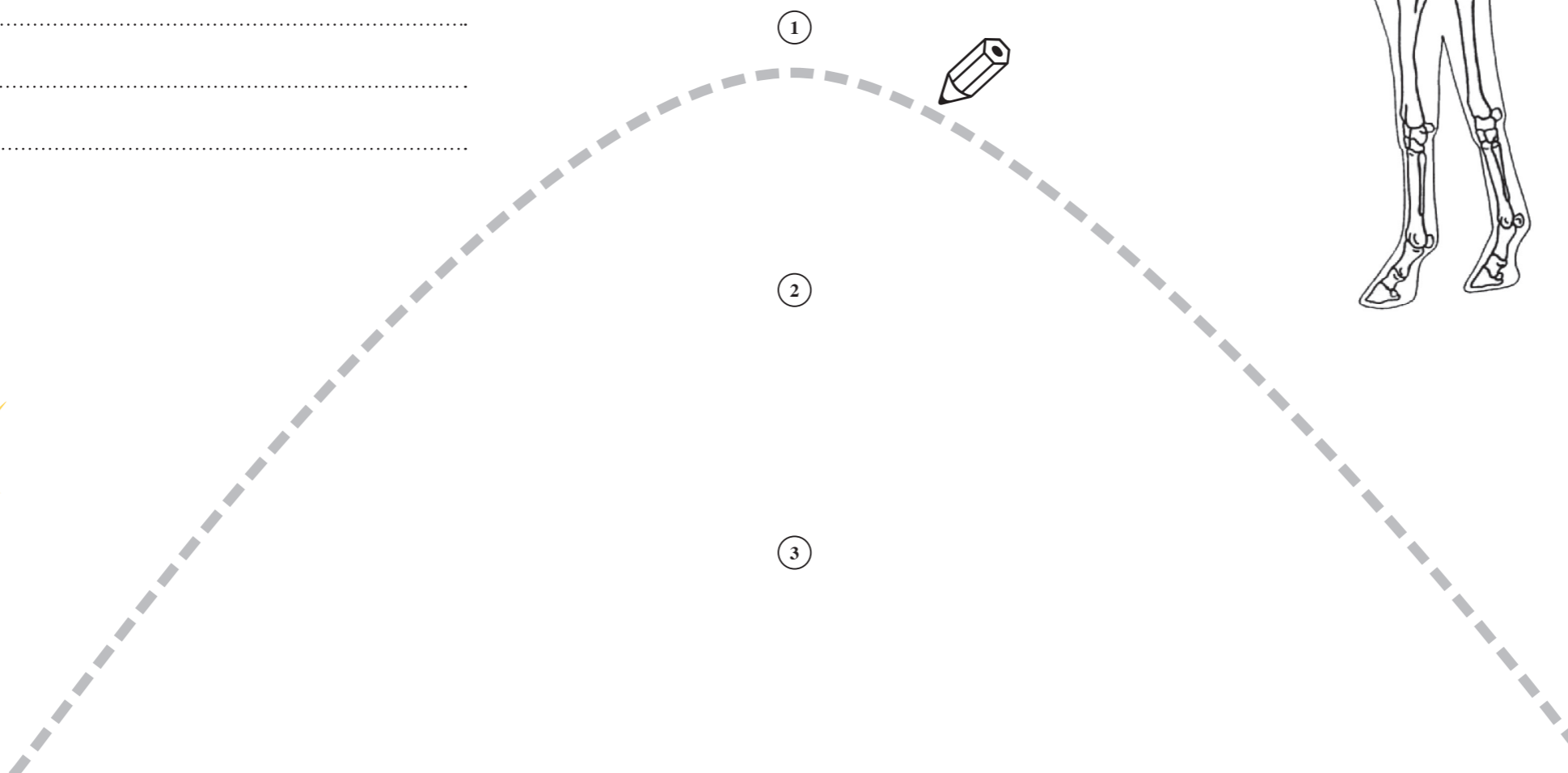
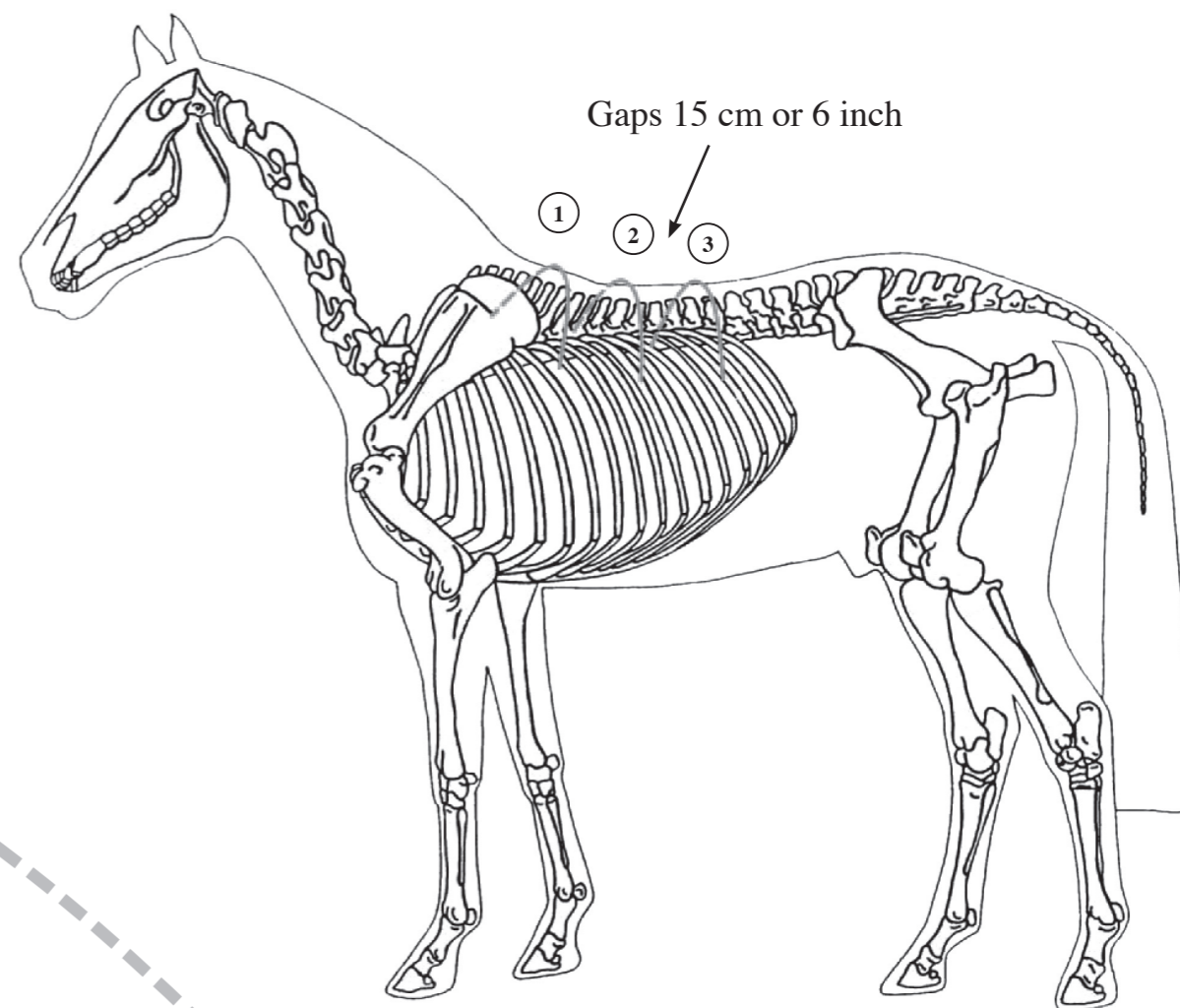

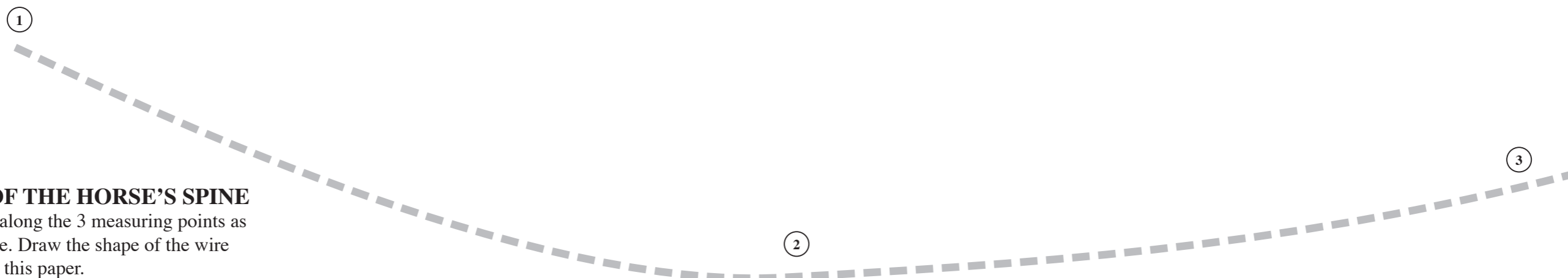
